



Dear Parents and Carers

** March 2021 Nursery Update **

I'm sure you will all agree its lovely to get some more favourable weather over the past couple of weeks – we of course have our fingers crossed that this will continue ☺

If your child is in preschool could we please ask that you pop your little ones in footwear that they can - as much as possible are able to take on and off independently. Although we are of course always here to help, it is really important that the pre-schoolers are promoted to be as independent as possible, especially those who are going off to school. In addition to this some of us ladies also don't have the required skill set with some of the shoes so it takes us extra time trying to get them on at busy points such as pick up times. Thank you in advance, it will be greatly appreciated.

Dangerous parking: We wanted to send an important reminder; we have received numerous complaints about the dangerous parking on the pavements outside nursery, which unfortunately means my previous polite requests are being disregarded by quite a few. PLEASE for the safety of your child as well as everyone else's I urge you not to park on the pavements outside nursery. We have also had an occasion last week where a parent waiting on the pavement outside was asked to move by a car driver so they could park on the pavement. I'm sure you can agree this is completely unacceptable. Obviously I am not able to police the parking and driving outside nursery so to a degree this is out of my hands, however I am sending another warning that it will cause an accident – and where there are children involved this accident could be serious. We are asking that every parent who drives to collect or drop off their child helps us to avoid any further complaints, or indeed a serious accident that is waiting to happen. We have to ask you yourselves to take responsibility to not park on the pavements and make your nursery pavements and roads safe.

Collections and waiting – we just wanted to send you a quick reminder that we do everything possible to get the children out in a speedy manner at the end of the day. We are aware that we can have quite a queue going but I can assure you we are all doing our very best to limit this and can only apologise if the waiting time is long on occasions. We are continuing to try and get a balancing act which involves ensuring we are being in depth enough for some parents who still require this, but speedy enough for others who are happy not to have the same level of hand over that they were perhaps used to when you were able to come in. I can assure you that we are doing our best to get children ready and get them to you from various rooms, whilst making sure that we keep to our room bubbles and ratios in

the rooms whilst staff are also handing over, as well as continuing to make sure that we have our heightened cleaning and sterilizing in place. All the ladies really do their very best and although on occasions from the outside it may seem slow going, I can assure you from the inside is what we call organised chaos to ensure that everything is done and most of all that the little ones are happy. Please be extra aware that pre-schoolers can take additional time, due to us still trying to promote their independence – a lot are off to school this year, and we must not take the opportunity away from them to get ready themselves and feel confident about doing so. Although we want a speedy get ready, sometimes it more important that a little one is given the time to put their own coat on and feel good about doing it without being rushed. We thank you again for your continued patience and understanding; we of course will continue to work hard to reduce your wait where ever possible.

Restrictions on children transitioning rooms due to Covid19: If your child is due to move to the next age group, we have had to revise how we do this due to government guidelines. Our old procedure included a variety of visits each week for a month to the next age group. This unfortunately cannot happen as it would mean mixing age group bubbles; we will be speaking to you individually if your child is affected, as transitions will be immediate at this time. We are very lucky that the children know all the staff which will help make the transition easier and wherever possible we are moving children in small groups so they go up with friends. We have had children move rooms already and they have all settled quickly and are enjoying exploring their new surroundings. Staff are being extra supportive with these children and making sure they are quickly settled and feel comfortable in their new surroundings.

An additional note, there may be a slight delay in your child transitioning to their next room. However, please be assured this will have no effect on their development as your child's key person will continue to provide challenging activities for your child at their level. The reason for this potential delay is due to our restrictions due to COVID and those who missed their transition during last year's lockdown.
